During the awards ceremony, an introduction by *athome*'s creative/editorial director Amy Vischio and opening remarks by Jane Green both reinforced the mission of the A-List Awards, which is to celebrate the area's best work and bring the design community together. "I believe that when we compete, our work gets better, and when we are genuinely good sportsmen, we, are better," says Vischio. "I'm completely interested in making our very own design community the best it can be in ways that go beyond aesthetics."
