During the awards, an introduction by athome's creative/editorial director Amy Vischio and opening remarks by Emma Jane Pilkington both reinforced the mission of the A-List Awards, which is to celebrate the area's best work and bring the design community together. "There can be a misperception that design is only about making things 'look good,'" says Vischio. "But when you take the time to read between the lines, you can see that these spaces are where we live our lives, where our families gather and grow, and ultimately, where the 'now' becomes the 'then' as memories are made. When spaces come together and feel good, this is when we know we've nailed the magical combination of craft and emotion."
